

I. Introduction


The Cost of Course Materials Impacts **Student Success**

- . A 2020 report by the *National Association of* College Stores found that students often:
- Delay purchasing required materials
- Buy only some of the assigned resources
- . These behaviors were confirmed by Florida Virtual Campus studies (2016, 2018 & 2022), which linked them to negative academic outcomes:
- Taking fewer courses
- Avoiding certain classes due to cost
- Lower grades
- . Withdrawals and course failures
- Rising costs are a barrier to student persistence and degree completion.



A Sustainable Path Forward

- . A long-term affordability solution is needed to replace CARES Act funding.
- . Open Educational Resources (OER) are viable alternatives to textbooks.
- Develop a syllabus review service to help faculty transition to OER and build long-term, affordable course design strategies.



II. Methods Consumer price indexes for tuition and school-related items, not seasonally **Extended Campus Syllabus Review Process**

- . The project team will review syllabi for Extended Campus courses.
- Extended Campus will recruit faculty to participate by submitting their syllabi.

Links to OER Research Products

Faculty participation includes:

- . Submitting a syllabus to be evaluated for material costs
- Completing a survey and/or joining a meeting about criteria for free or lower-cost resources
- Meeting with the project team to explore affordable alternatives to required texts.
- . Submitting a revised syllabus if lower-cost materials are adopted

Creation of a Repository


- Revised syllabi archived in Aggie Digital Collections & Scholarship, N.C. A&T's institutional repository.
- The project team collaborated with the Bibliographic, Metadata, and Discovery unit
 - Create the syllabus collection
 - Upload documents
 - Assign appropriate metadata
- . Repository is freely available to the public.
- Enables faculty and students to find affordable materials.

III. Results

- 365 syllabi analyzed from across all colleges in the university.
- . 120 syllabi uploaded to the digital collection "Open Educational Resources Syllabus Review"
- Potential savings estimated at \$102.00 per course textbook.
- . Increased librarian-faculty collaboration and awareness of OER initiatives.
- . OER Toolkit research guide.

IV. Conclusions

- · Identified faculty currently using or creating OER.
- Build strong relationships with department heads to promote initiatives effectively.
- Develop student-focused programming to support project success and foster dialogue between students and faculty.
- Future initiatives will build on outcomes to improve the review service and enhance affordability efforts.
- Project workflows will be integrated into regular staff and liaison duties to ensure sustainability.
- Workshops and consultations on OER and low-cost materials will continue to be offered.
- Additional syllabi will be added to the library's digital collection in the institutional repository.
